RULES OF CONDUCT FOR LIBRARY USERS OF THE

ORISKANY PUBLIC LIBRARY

- 1. On the premises of the library, the violation of any federal or state statutes or local ordinances will also be regarded as a violation of library rules.
- 2. Persons in apparent violation of any of these laws are to be reported to the police by the highest ranking staff member present. Legal action may also be taken through the filing of a complaint.
- 3. Patrons are expected to act in a manner that does not inhibit the ability of other patrons to use the library. Also, patrons are expected to treat library property and personnel respectfully. It is incumbent upon the library staff to see that the rights of individuals using the library are upheld. The following actions will take place upon infringement of acceptable behavior:

1st offense-----verbal warning
2nd offense----expulsion for that day

3rd offense-----expulsion for a month.(If the offender is a minor, a written notice shall be sent to the parent or guardian).

4. Library staff is not expected to assume responsibility for the care of unsupervised minors in the library.
